

CEDAR CAMPUS IS RESPONDING TO THE CONCERNS OF YOUR FAMILY IN THIS SEASON.

Thank you for your patience in this trying time. Know that your health, safety, and well-being are our highest priority here at Cedar. We are taking appropriate steps to ensure camp is a safe environment where you and your family can come away, meet God and be renewed.



Here are a few actions we have taken:

- Increased cleaning and disinfection protocols with special care given to high contact areas.
- Review of our protocols and procedures to prevent, limit, and mitigate communicable disease transmission at camp.
- Updated information for local and regional health centers for assistance as needed.
- Creation and review of isolation protocols for anyone showing signs of respiratory illness.
- Monitoring the developing situation and seeking the best scholarly information and expert advice.

Here are a few important steps you can take:

- Practice good hygiene – wash your hands frequently with soap and water.
- Come to camp rested and nourished so that you are as resilient as possible.
- Politely decline close physical contact with others (no hugs, or handshakes).
- Screen your group – Do not allow participation or travel to camp by anyone with the following symptoms: fever, runny nose, cough, or body aches. Even if they say they are “getting over it.”
- Stay informed: Seek quality information from the CDC and WHO (World Health Organization).
- Pray – for all those suffering from the disease and for all those who are responding to the ongoing crisis.

We are by nature a place that gathers people for ministry and fellowship, it is a difficult time, but out of concern for the greater needs of our community and in observance of national and state restrictions we have cancelled or postponed spring programs up until May 30th. We will reevaluate summer programs on April 15. There are no current plans to cancel those programs. If you have made a reservation for a Cedar program for June and beyond, we are continuing to pray, plan, and prepare to hold the camp as scheduled. We will communicate with you directly if there is any change in status of these events.
